NOTES ON PRONUNCIATION:

All letters are pronounced in an American English fashion, with all vowels assuming the longer phonetic pronunciations, and with repetitions of the same letters (i.e. - ii, iii, ee, or eee) lengthening the sound for a period of one half a second for every reiteration. When a consonant and vowel coexist in one word, remember that consonants are dominant, whereas vowels are recessive; the consonant modifies the vowel so that it ends with an "EM" sound, while the consonants remain unchanged. When punctuation exists alongside both in a single word, the consonant - no matter which - always reverts to a loud "KROU," and the palette formations for vowel sounds are pushed to the absolute rear of the mouth.

Punctuation and numeral pronunciations, individually, are best described as follows:

, is a guttural stop.

: is an exhalation.

. is a simultaneous utterance of the normal pronunciation for "period" and that same word in reverse.

- is the engine-like sound a child makes when playing with toy cars.

/ is the sound a young black male makes when greeting a curvaceous (or appropriately thick) member of the opposite sex.

1 is the sound of a fist-sized stone dropping into a shallow well.

2 is the sound of a foghorn echoing off drifting shoals of dry ice.

3 is the sound of a Xerox machine, deep in a forest on the Canadian mainland, trapped on the third branch of a small pine tree with an overweight gray cat named Boo.

4 is the sound Brad makes when he slips on the banana, falls off the scaffolding, and lands on the empty stroller - leaving the bystanders to assume that an infant was killed in the process, and thus, to rally until the city of Chicago sues both him, them, themselves, the scaffolding manufacturer, and the banana.
